Project Resource Management

A one-day course which revises the overall Project Management process and discusses why resources are inherently always a problem in project planning. The course investigates the different resource types, and encompasses contracting as a common solution for people resource problems.

Methods to solve resource shortages are discussed including changing plans, changing schedules, adding more resources, or changing project objectives.

This 'Resource Management' aspect of Project Management is then put to the test in a safe environment during the afternoon session in a Project Management Simulation.
