

Simple Icebreaker – Lost Luggage

Lost Luggage is a great way to get a dozen or so people mixing at a meeting. This activity is especially pertinent if the participants have travelled to be with you.

Copy the second sheet of luggage labels and cut out sufficient Luggage Labels for the number of participants at the event.

Distribute the labels and invite participants to add 5 interesting facts about themselves onto the label.

These could be:

- Something descriptive about their appearance.
- Their hobby.
- The type of pet that they have.
- The make of car that they drive.
- Something unusual and revealing.
- Or something else.....

Collect the labels back in, and then randomly distribute them to the participants.

Allow the participants 15 minutes to wander around, introducing themselves as they search for the owner of their Lost Luggage Label. They are also searching for their own Lost Luggage.

At the end of the event, collect all the labels in, and then read them aloud in turn. Hopefully, all of the participants will recognise who the Lost Luggage belongs to.
