

<u>Virtual – VIP</u>

We have all probably met (or been really close to) a famous person.

This virtual icebreaker simply goes around the participants asking them to describe the situation and circumstances of their own meeting, but without revealing the name.

The remaining participants can guess at the name as more information is revealed.

"I once travelled on a famous airline. The Aircraft was called the Maiden Voyager. I was travelling across the Atlantic. The owner of the Airline boarded the

plane and stood next to me, whilst chatting to the airhostess. He returned the £10 to her that he (a millionaire!) had borrowed! Yes, - it is Richard Branson."

When the identity of the VIP is revealed, the participant can nominate the next person to describe their own VIP meeting.

The facilitator is required to keep a check on who has taken part, and who is yet to play the game.

If a participant is struggling to think of a VIP, you might suggest that they choose a famous person who they would like to meet. They may then need to be inventive about the situation.

An ideal game for breaking the ice and fills the time as more participants arrive in the virtual meeting room.

At the end of the session reiterate the importance of your training course or meeting. Mention that your company has its own VIP's (senior management!) who want the best results from the training course or meeting.
